



MCS Remote Learning Progressive Discipline Plan

As we begin the journey of remote learning at MCS, the reality is that we will be walking through some uncharted territory together. As such, we recognize the need for grace and space as we all learn how to make this work. However, in order to create a digital learning environment which allows all students to achieve academic success and experience the same support and safety they would in the physical classroom, all students will be expected to follow the digital classroom expectations set forth by their teachers and treat all teachers, staff members, and students with respect and care. In addition, we ask for your partnership and support from home to ensure that all students have the best digital learning experience possible.

Should students continue to struggle with digital classroom expectations even after grace and space have been extended, the following progressive discipline plan will be followed.

Minor Offenses:

Level 1: Verbal warning/redirection

Level 2: Parent email/phone call by teacher or dean

Level 3: Video conference or call with parent, student, and dean; iPad restrictions

Level 4: Loss of ability to attend one or more Zoom live sessions (student would need to wait until the recording of the session is available)

Major Offenses:

-Outside the Progressive Discipline Plan

-Require immediate attention and counsel from the Dean

-To be handled on case by case basis with direct admin-parent communication

-Most likely addressed at Level 3 or Level 4
