To be eligible, the candidate must have applied and/or been accepted for enrollment at a college, junior college, or trade school or must be joining the military. Scholarships will be awarded in the range of \$1000-\$2000.

The Core Values of MCS include: Love for Christ, Exemplary Academics, Whole Child Focus, Connected Community, and Culture of Innovation. Applicants are encouraged to demonstrate these values throughout their application. Complete the entire application packet by filling in the application and returning it, along with the requirements listed below, by **Friday, April 26, 2024**. We request that students independently complete the application packet.

Include all the following items:

o Application form.

- o Current color photograph. (Preferably your senior photo)
- o Current high school transcript. (Please attach most recent copy)
- o Recommendation letter from an individual that can attest to ways you have demonstrated leadership and service.
- (e.g. pastor, teacher, counselor, principal, coach, small group leader, mentor, or employer.)

o Recommendation letter from an MCS teacher who can speak to your spiritual growth and character throughout high school. (optional but preferred)

o Responses to all essay questions. (must be typed)
